The <u>Department of Homeland Security</u> celebrated their remarkable success securing our homeland and restoring law and order as they bring needed safety to our communities.




In one month of @POTUS Trump:

Daily border encounters have plunged 93%.


ICE arrests of criminals have doubled.

We will continue fighting every day to make America safe again.




The <u>Department of State</u> commemorated the return to President Trump's America First foreign policy that advances peace through strength.
